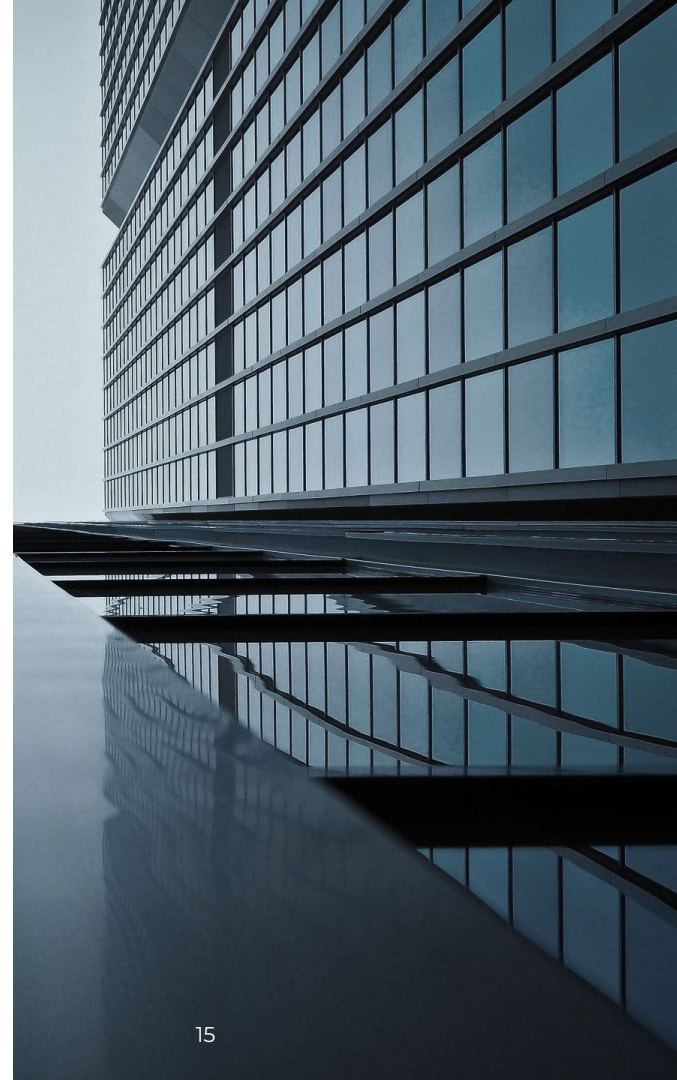
Tableau Desktop I: Fundamentals and Tableau Desktop II: Intermediate, or comparable product experience.
